We have found as our business has grown that we need to make clear what we look for in a consignment relationship. Relationship is key, we want to know you. We would like to be able to pass along knowledge of you and your craft to interested customers. We pride ourselves in appreciating the handmade, and supporting the handmade movement. Customers like to buy art that they have a bit of information about.

i like you provides a place to sell your creations, we will do our best to display and promote your items beautifully.

You as a consigner must provide us with product in a timely manner.

Please look over our contract, to insure you agree with our terms.

We are always looking for new artists and crafters.

We also look for those of you who know a craft well enough to teach classes. We have ample classroom space.

Interested artists should refer to these guidelines:

1. Send to us an email with the following information; angela.ilikeyou@gmail.com

-Your contact information. Please include name, full address and email address.

-Photographs of your work in JPEG format, a reasonable size please.

-Detailed description of your work, including sizes and colors.

-An estimate of what your product might sell for (retail price).

-A little tidbit about yourself, anything you may want us to know about who you are

PLEASE do not stop into the store unannounced with samples of your work. Your time is valuable, and so is ours. **i like you** is a partnership, we need time to look over potential merchandise together. We do not accept merchandise on the spot. There are many things to consider when making these decisions such as: do these items "fit" into the general aesthetic that **i like you** is going for? Are these items seasonally appropriate? Do we feel they are affordably priced? and so on ...

If we feel that we must see your creations in person, we will contact you and an appointment will be made.

2. This is the hard part ...WAIT.

Sometimes we take quite a while in getting back to you. There are only two of us, and honestly we don't think anyone realizes that there is always an ongoing list of things to do.

We do keep a file on potential artists, we refer to it often. Just because you did not get an immediate reply, does not mean we have forgotten about your work.
